Role Title:

Bronze Incident Responder

Reporting to:

Bronze Incident Response Team Leader

Role Description:

The main activities/duties of this role include;

- To fully participate in the incident responder rota
- To comply with KIJ / TSA policy in relation to incidents attended
- Other general duties as issued by the Bronze Incident Team Leader or Head of Operations
- To maintain a proactive presence within an assigned area in order to anticipate and report any potential incidents
- To respond to requests for help / assistance from KIJ participants
- To communicate with JamCOM the need for any further assistance
- To provide additional support to Welfare / Fire / Medical / Security response if required
- To respond to incidents allocated by JamCOM and provide initial on scene management and resolve if able, examples being...lost child, breach of KIJ Policy, safety incident, logistical challenge

Essential Requirements:

- A member of either the Scout or Guiding Associations, or a willingness to join either
- Be over 18
- Hold a current DBS check and ensure it is valid for the event. (DBS number will be required)
- Can organise, manage and communicate in a consistent, professional manner
- Hold a Scout / Guide First Aid qualification
- Be friendly, welcoming and have a personable approach





- Be willing to work at obscure times and unsociable hours – shift work is required for this role due to 24hr cover
- Able to make effective decisions and operate under pressure
- Confident in working in a team

Nice to haves:

- Have experience of jamboree teams or similar either inside or outside of Scouting/Guiding.
